Introduction

The COVID-19 preventive lockdown has changed the life of every individual in the country. While the lockdown is laudable and very much required to fight the pandemic, it has also lead to numerous problems, especially for the underprivileged section of the society. The low income families live in urban and rural were affected by the sudden lockdown. The situation led to hunger, poverty, and malnutrition, loss of jobs and employment and livelihood especially for the migrants, daily wage earners and collies. And shockingly, many children have become even more vulnerable to exploitation. Children belonging to the economically weaker sections of the society have become susceptible to exploitation due to financial crisis.

In response to this crisis Don Bosco Anbu Illam acted upon supporting the needy children and their families. As an initial process we mapped the deserving children families, underprivileged families' migrants in Salem and Namakkal District. We decided to support the families with Grocery materials required for a family for one month.




























Phase 1 Distributions

Neighborhood of our staff:



Distributed 94 bags of Grocery to families in Salem. Each Staff in our organization identified 2 to 3 needy families in their neighborhood and had helpful them by way of giving 94 set of ration item (groceries) pack in various part of the Salem district. It helped them to continue their meals during this Covid-19 lockdown period.

Families of children in children's home:

Due to the outbreak of COVID 19 Our Don Bosco Anbu Illam - Shelter Home children have been sent to their relatives / guardians for temporary care. We followed up by phone and enquired about their family situation in the time of Lockdown. We found children have been struggling for food and for other needs. We supported with Grocery items for children from children homes. We have reached out to 42 families so far. We have been travelling as for as 80 kms (One Way) to reach four families.



Collaborating with the City Corporation:

With the collaboration of Corporation administration, we distributed grocery to families of 25 sanitary (Health Workers) staff.

Collaborating with District Administration:

We handed over grocery for 25 poor daily wages families and migrated families to the District Administration in the collectorate.

Relief work in most deserving area (Panchanthangi Lake):

Responding to appeal through social media by the people of Karunkalpatti, Panjathaangi Eri, Maavu Mill for assistance, supported them with Grocery items. The people of Panchanthangi lake posted a video in social media regarding their suffering for meals

due to unemployment and also, they didn't get any Government schemes because they

don't have any basic proof like ration card during this lockdown period in. On seeing this post the director of Don Bosco Anbu Illam, Salem sent a staff team to identify the families those who are really deserving and also without ration card. As a result, 26 families were identified and groceries were distributed to them dated on 20.04.20

In addition we supported 45 families with provided groceries (with 21 Items). The families were referred to us by Salem South Thasildar and Mr. Saravana Kumar VAO of

Through CHILDLINE 1098

Through childline 1098 we had received calls from various parts of Salem district for nutrition support. We distributed grocery to 24 families in various parts of Salem District.



Neermullikuttai Village



On 14.05.20 supported 30 needy families at Neermullikuttai village, vazhapadi with the coordination of Salem people Trust. The grocery items were distributed by Fr. Santhanam, Director, Don Bosco Anbulllam and Mr. Jeyam, Founder, Salem People Trust.



Relief work in Namakkal District – Rasipuram

Relief work in Rasipuram taluk:

The Don Bosco Anbu Illam Society is catering towards the empowerment of young women who work in the spinning mills of Rasipuram, Nammakkal District. We also work against the child labour in 30 villages in and around the locality. Identified 400 families affected by this pandemic. 250 families from our working



villages and more t 150 migrants were affected due to the Covid -19 lock down. After the Identification of needy people our Don Bosco Anbu Illam Society through "Freedom Fund" gave groceries worth Rs.1015 for each family. This was regarded as great help by the beneficiaries.



In Stage 2 from 23 June 2020 to 30 June 2020, Grocery & food materials Worth of Rs.1000 (1 bag) were distributed to the community group and village people in the targeted villages. 671 members of Differently abled

people, windows, vulnerable people and 59 migrants from Bihar and Orissa were benefitted through the distribution of food materials.
